

### 3 Person Basketball Test Questions:



1. Prior to the game when the officials take the floor at the 15 minute mark the U1 has the responsibility of counting the visiting team.
2. Prior to the tip off the U2 lines up tableside to start the clock on the tip.
3. Once the tip off has concluded the referee will always become the C.
4. The trail official has responsibility for the last shot prior to the end of a quarter.
5. The C is responsible for the end line out of bounds.
6. The rotation is initiated by the trail.
7. The C can initiate a rotation on trap at the division line on a press.
8. The official who reports a shooting foul will become the C.
9. The official who reports a non shooting foul in the frontcourt will report the foul and replace the official who is table side.
10. When reporting a foul all the officials will change positions.
11. The official who administers the free throw from the end line will position him/herself opposite the table.
12. On the free throw lineup the trail official will lineup and center court and retreat on the free throw attempt to cover the anticipated play of going in the opposite direction.
13. When the lead official portrays a closed down position he/she will have the 3 point shot behind them in the corner.
14. On a double whistle between the lead and C on a play that left the C area going to the lead the lead assumes the primary area on this call therefore making the foul call.
15. In a pressing situation the C and lead official clear the backcourt and take positions in the front court waiting for the play to develop on this side of the court.
16. On a free throw attempt that will start the clock the trail official is responsible for starting the clock.
17. When the lead initiates a rotation he/she has the ability to go directly and completely across the lane to the other side of the court to the sideline.
18. When the calling official makes a player control in the front court there is a switch on the change of possession.

19. The lead official will take responsibility of all substitutions entering the game on the change of possession.
20. The lead may force a rotation under 3 seconds on the shot clock or game clock to end a quarter.
